

New DNK Cyber Cover

– a complete insurance offering



Why was the cover created?

Cyber risk is a growing concern for global trade. To help protect Norwegian maritime assets against cyber risks, DNK and the Norwegian Shipowners' Association founded NORMA Cyber in 2021.

Cyber War risks for vessels have been covered under the standard DNK war policy since 2005. From April 1st 2024, DNK members are able to complete their existing cover with the market's most comprehensive insurance solution for maritime cyber risks, the new DNK Cyber Cover, which offers incident response support and cover for cyber losses for the entire onshore operation and fleet under one single policy.

Who can buy this cover?

The new DNK Cyber Cover is an optional, additional cover, offered exclusively to shipowners who are members of both DNK and NORMA Cyber. To qualify for the marine cyber insurance, vessels have to have an active war policy with DNK and be entered under the member's name.




What is covered?

The cover includes cover against a wide range of losses from malicious cyberattacks, up to a limit of USD 10mill for onshore assets, and USD 50mill for vessels, including:

-  Incident Response services
-  Digital Assets Restoration
-  Business Interruption
-  Dependent Business Interruption
-  Third Party Liability
-  Defence costs
-  Cyber Extortion (Ransomware)
-  E-Crime (Electronic Theft, Fraud, Manipulation) - USD 250k sublimit
-  Hull and Machinery
-  Loss of Hire Physical Damage - 180 days / USD 25m sublimit
-  **Optional:** Loss of Hire non-Physical Damage - 180 days / USD 5m sublimit
